
# **Investing for Success**

### This funding will be used to

- Support teachers to deepen their knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum.
- Develop and embed a consistent, whole school reading strategy to improve literacy outcomes for all students including targeted reading intervention for students identified as likely to fall below a 'C' in English.
- Develop the capacity and capability of staff to respond to and implement, effective pedagogical practices to meet the learning needs of a diverse range of students.
- Further develop Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) processes, routines and practices to proactively support every students' participation in learning and to achieve tier two.

#### **Our initiatives include**

- Collaborativey build staff capability and teacher expertise to plan and implement the Australian Curriculum through professional development incorporating collaborative curriculum planning processes.
- Collaboratively review the school's early years phonics program and whole-school literacy strategy.
- Employ Teacher Aides to provide targeted literacy support in every classroom during literacy blocks.
- Build staff capacity and capability to embed a consistent understanding and implementation of PBL processes, routines and practices to further promote positive student engagement in learning.
- Review the school's programs and approaches to supporting student mental health and wellbeing, including the documentation of a Student Learning and Wellbeing Framework.
- Collaboratively develop a 'Parent and Community Code of Conduct' to include the elements of engagement: Communication, Collaboration and School Culture aligned to the Department of Education's policy "Occupational Violence and Aggression Prevention Strategy".
